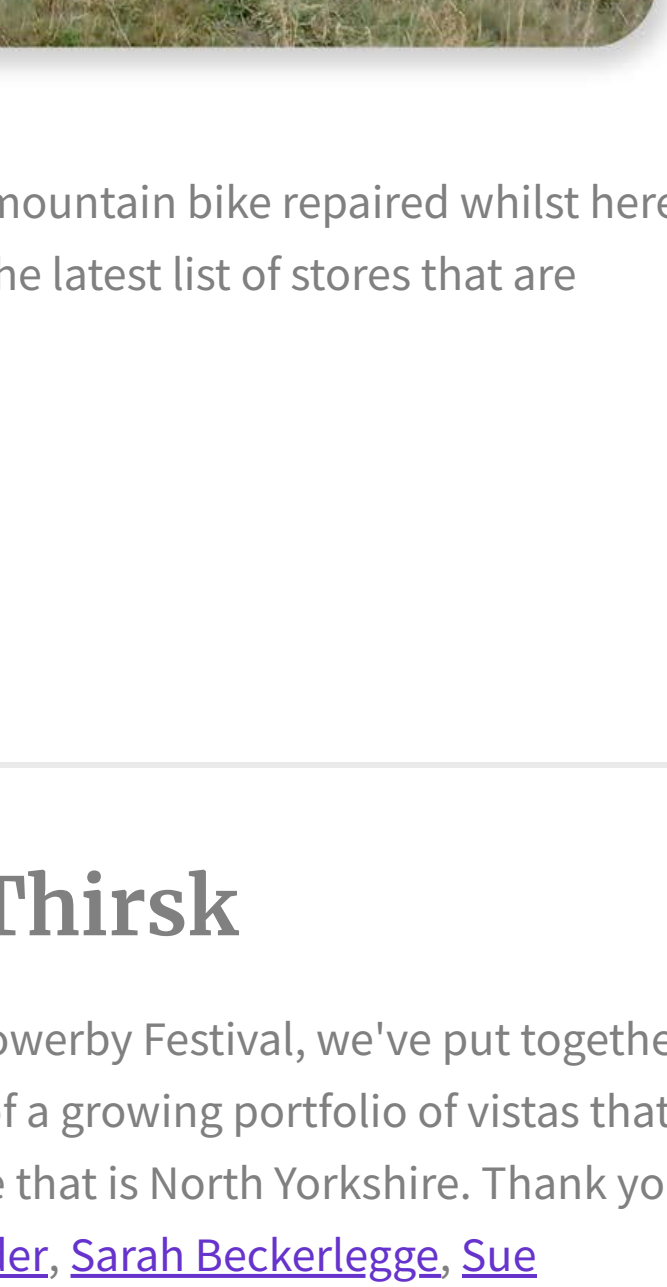
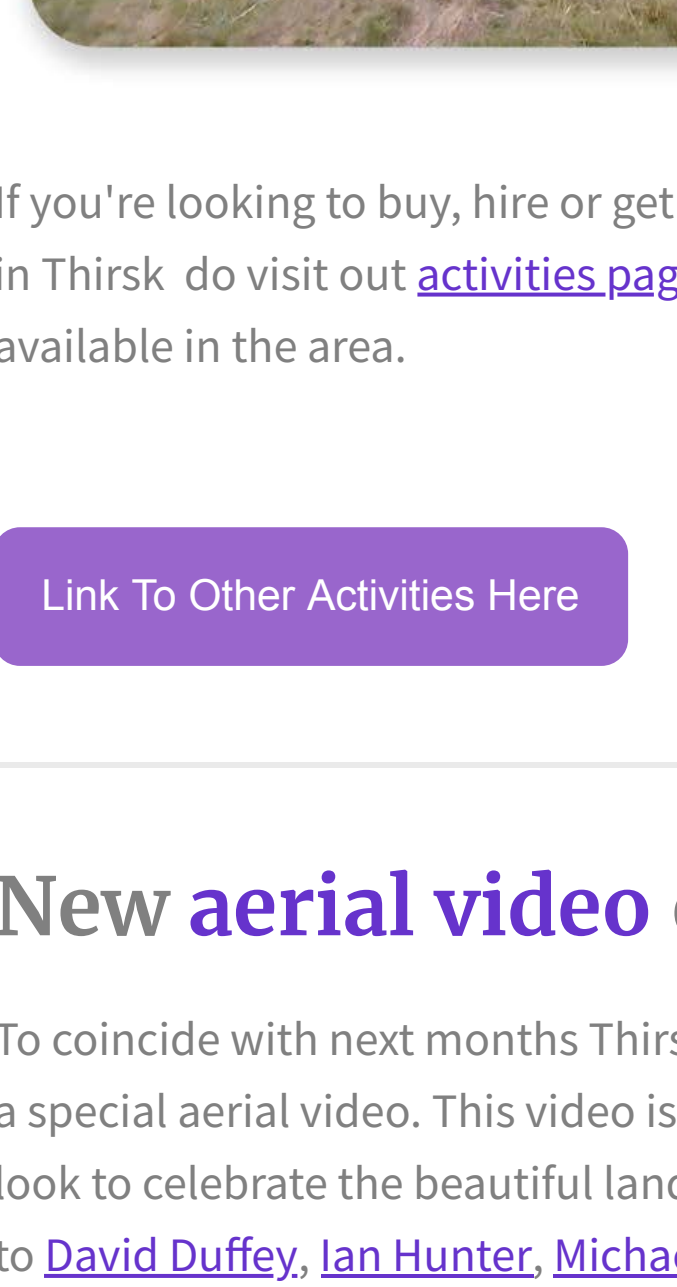


Hello

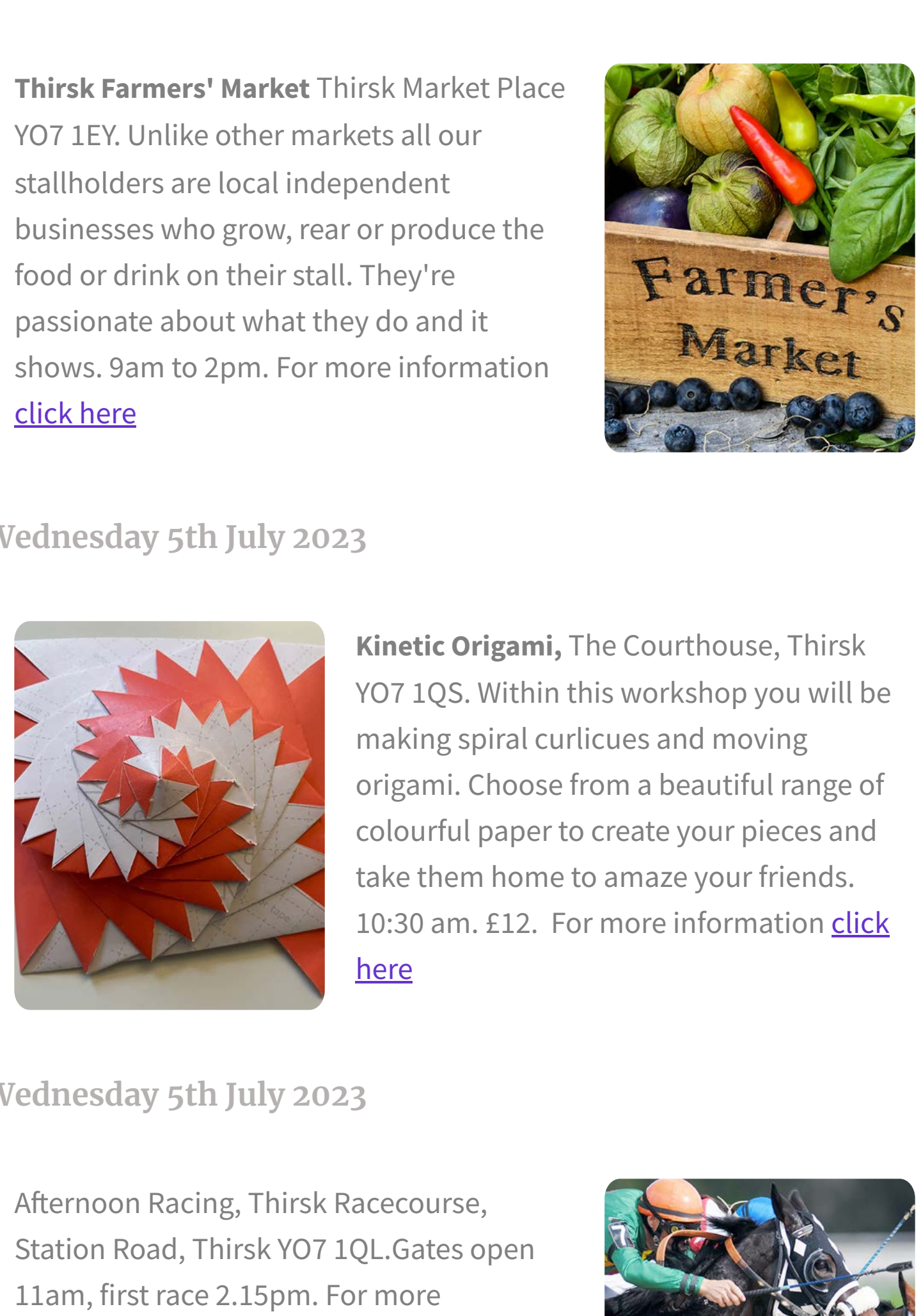

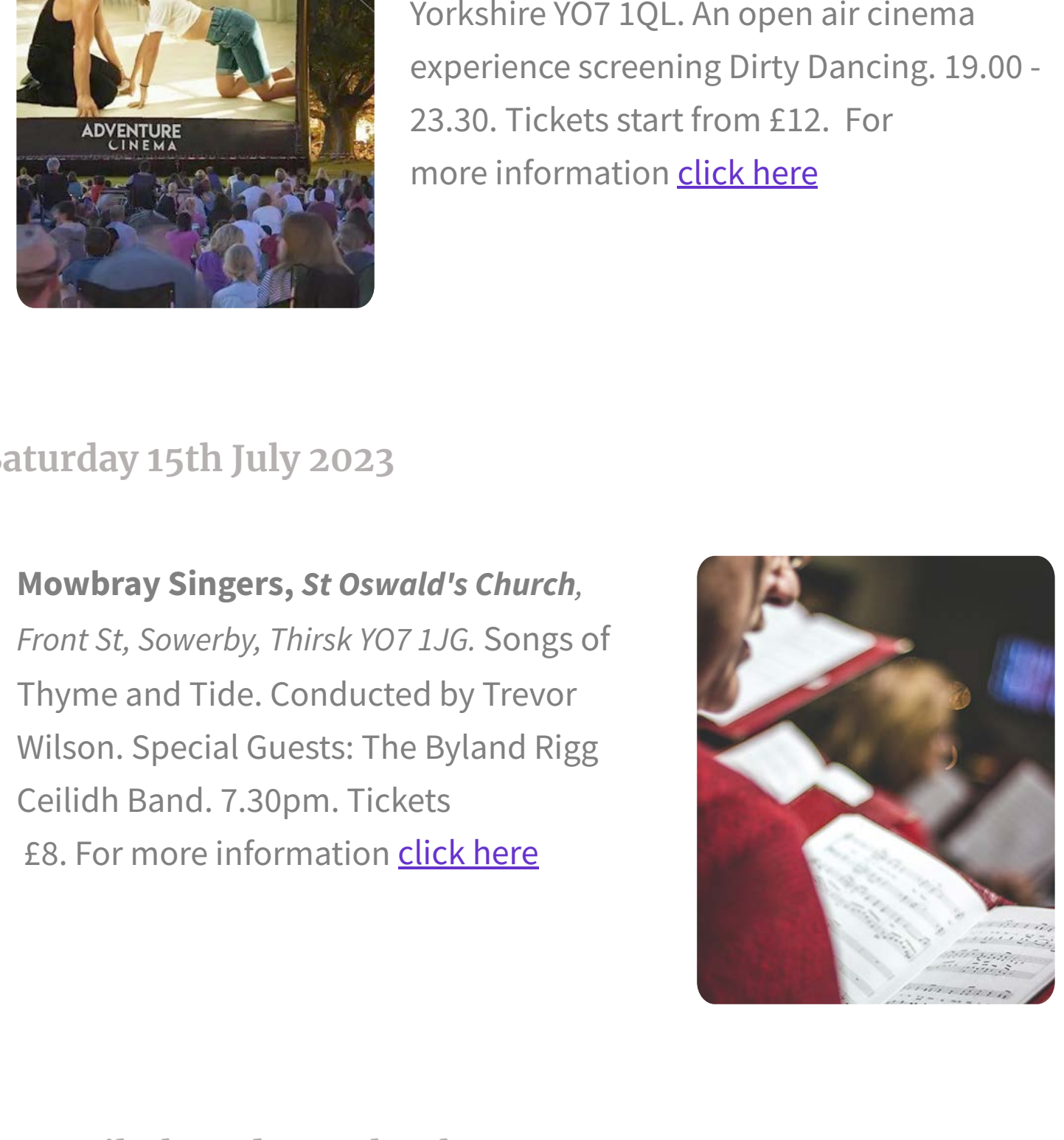
